SUBJECT: Transportation for 2017 Boys State and Girls State Attendees

I have again contracted a motor coach to transport the Upper Peninsula students who are attending the 2017 Boys State and Girls State programs. This will be a 56-passenger motor coach from American Tour Club in Gladwin, Michigan. I am currently employed part time by this company as a motor coach operator. As a way to keep costs down, I am volunteering my time and will not be paid to drive on either the trip to or from Boys State and Girls State. Diana Mella, Unit 50 member, has volunteered to accompany me as the chaperone.

The dates of the 2017 Boys and Girls State are June 18-24, 2017. The transportation cost per student is \$100.00. Please make checks payable to: **American Tour Club** and mail to: John M. Please mail the checks to me **by June 1, 2017**. **Be sure to include, with your payment, the student's name(s) and phone number and indicate the location where they will be picked up, so I can make a roster of who is to be picked up at each scheduled stop.**

Post/Unit/Squadron: It is your responsibility to see that your Girls State or Boys State attendee receives a copy of this schedule!

*******PLEASE NOTE*******

Because all times are approximate, please plan to arrive at each pick up location at least 15 minutes early. The same applies for parents who are picking up the students on the return trip. That way, if we are running early, we will have the option to continue on without waiting. Also, we will leave each location ***exactly*** on time. **If you are not at your scheduled pick up location by the scheduled leave time, we will continue on to the next location.** If you arrive too late to be picked up at your scheduled location, you can travel on to the next pick up location. Anyone who misses their scheduled pick up is responsible for their own transportation to Boys State or Girls State. **All fees paid for transportation are non-refundable.**
