Please **carefully read all the information** that is available on our Department website: [www.michalaux.org](http://www.michalaux.org), click on Girls State, so you will be familiar with our program and rules. We would like to stress that this is a full, seven day session which can be physically, mentally and emotionally challenging. The program is structured as a very intensive learning situation and involves walking from the dorm to classrooms. If you or your daughter's physician feels she is unable to enter into the activities without ill effects, you should notify her sponsor, immediately.

**Transportation to and from the program is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Delegates living in Michigan's Upper Peninsula can make arrangements to reserve a seat on the UP Bus. Delegates living in the upper portion of Lower Michigan, along the UP-Bus route, can also inquire regarding the possibility of riding the bus, providing space is available. The bus will be traveling from the UP to Grand Valley State University. If your daughter is in need of transportation, please contact Girls State Committee member, Diana Mella, at [grandmadi6@yahoo.com](mailto:grandmadi6@yahoo.com), or 989-640-0109 to see if those arrangements can be made.**

Please be advised that your daughter will be expected to pay for any linens, bedding, meal card, room key or shower room key, if not turned in to Michigan State University at checkout. The University applies this regulation to all organizations using its facilities.

Citizens may depart on Saturday, June 23th, following the Awards Ceremony which will end at approximately 4:30 p.m. Parents may attend this ceremony, however seating is very limited. It will be held in Wells Hall room B115 starting at 3:00 p.m. **No parent will be allowed to enter Shaw Hall prior to the Award Ceremony for early luggage pick up or any other reason.**

They will receive a copy of this manual when they arrive at Girls State, however, having a chance to study it prior to their arrival will assist them with the bar exam that is administered first thing Monday morning!

If your daughter is eligible to apply for the Samsung Scholarship please make sure all the rules for completing the form are followed. Lack of the proper signatures, information, and military discharge documentation for the relative they qualify under, will result in disqualification. **This scholarship application is now completed on-line, and must be submitted prior to arriving at Girls State.**
