<u>DEPARTMENT CONVENTION</u> convenes on Thursday, June 27, 2019 at the Radisson Hotel in Kalamazoo, Michigan. The registration desk will open for <u>early</u> registration on Wednesday evening from 5-7 pm.

REGISTRATION: ANYONE attending the Convention Delegate, Alternate, Member or Guest, MUST REGISTER with the Convention Corporation. The registration form is enclosed. Please follow the mailing and payment instructions on the form. The registration fee is \$15.

HOUSING:

The hotel reservations MUST be made directly through the Radisson Hotel in Kalamazoo, MI. A Hotel Information sheet with instructions is also enclosed.

<u>CREDENTIAL INFORMATION</u>: THE "Official Call for Department Convention" appeared in the April/May issue of the Auxiliaire. The Certification of Unit Delegates form is enclosed. The number of Delegates each Unit is allowed is based on the number of members 30 days prior to Convention, this year being May 26th.

Please note that if you are allowed 4 Delegates, as an example, if you pay to register 4 Delegates, <u>even if only one Delegate attends, that delegate can vote all 4 votes</u>. If you only register 2 Delegates, you would only get to vote two of the four you are allowed. You should also list the same number of Alternates in the event a Delegate cannot attend.

Please advise your delegates that they <u>must present their convention name tag</u> at the official credentials desk in Kalamazoo before 8:30 am on Saturday, June 29, 2019 to receive the appropriate sticker in order to be entitled to vote in the election to be held Saturday morning.

<u>FLAG REHEARSAL</u>: The rehearsal for the Flag Processional will be held at 2:00 pm on Thursday afternoon, June 27, 2019 in the Convention meeting room. Please be sure to advise the Department Headquarters if you are planning to bring your colors to the convention. A form is enclosed for this purpose. DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION OF COLORS IS JUNE 1. Be sure to designate someone who is responsible for picking up your flag and stand after the closing of the Convention. Be sure to clearly label your flag and stand.

DISTRICT CAUCUS: Your delegates should attend their District Caucus on Thursday afternoon at 3:00 pm and return to the caucus following the pre-convention meetings.

PRE-CONVENTION MEETINGS: The District Presidents will assign a meeting for a delegate to attend. The delegate will report back to the caucus what was talked about at the meeting. Your delegates and alternates should be instructed to be seated with your District Delegation in the Convention Hall. They will follow the direction of the District President.



Annually, the NATIONAL VETERANS CREATIVE ARTS FESTIVAL recognizes, promotes and supports the therapeutic influence of the Arts in the lives of Veterans with health challenges. These Veterans, submitting over 5000 judged entries, produce results that are astounding and inspiring.

This year Michigan was selected as the host state. This week-long event takes place October 28-November 3, 2019, in Kalamazoo, Michigan. As co-sponsor, the American Legion Auxiliary, a 501c-19 organization, will supply and host the Hospitality Room daily. Snacks, food items, non-alcoholic drinks, etc., along with "Welcome/Departure Bags" will be available to the Veterans and their companions cost free. This is an alternative source for those unable to purchase the \$25/per meal ticket. We also provide food and beverage items for off-campus venues and field trips. Our goal of \$25,000, if possible, will include a Sunday dinner banquet ticket for those unable to purchase.

This is where we need your help. Did you know, with our current membership of 25,222 paid-up members, we could easily meet our goal if everyone pitched in just a dollar! We are asking that your Unit consider a donation towards the NVCAF and every penny counts! We have already received donations totaling \$2,400, but much more is needed. All donations for this event can be paid from either your VA&R or Poppy Fund.


