SUBJECT: Transportation for 2026 Girls State Attendees ONLY

I have again contracted a motor coach to transport the Upper Peninsula students who are attending the 2026 Girls State program. This will be a 56-passenger motor coach from Jag Motorcoach Company, Gladwin, Michigan. I am currently employed by this company as a motor coach operator. To keep costs down, I am volunteering my time to transport the students to and from Michigan Girls State. My wife, Diana, is volunteering her time to assist me during the trip to Girls State.

The dates of the 2026 Michigan Girls State program are **June 14th - 20th, 2026**. The transportation cost per student is **\$150.00**.

Ridge Road, Gladwin, MI 48624. **Be sure to include, with your payment, the name(s) and phone number(s) of the student(s) you are paying for. Also, indicate the location where they will be picked up, so I can make a roster of who is to be picked up at each scheduled stop.**

Post/Unit/Squadron: It is your responsibility to see that each Michigan Girls State attendees receive a copy of this schedule!

2:30 pm Bus leaves the carpool lot

3:30 pm Bus arrives at the McDonald's Restaurant parking lot, 928 US-2, St. Ignace
3:45 pm Bus leaves the parking lot

6:45pm – 7:15 pm Bus arrives at Michigan State University, East Lansing (Girls State Location) – **TBD**

NOTE: Students will be dropped off at the same locations where they were picked up, unless other arrangements are made in advance with John M Mella (906.774.0538).

- 4:30 pm Pick up the girls at Michigan State University, East Lansing
- 8:45 pm Arrive at the McDonald's Restaurant parking lot, located at 928 US-2, St Ignace
9:00 pm Bus leaves the parking lot
- 10:00 pm Arrive at the MI Carpool Lot, at the junction of M-117 and US-2, south of Engadine
10:15 pm Bus leaves the parking lot
- 11:00 pm Arrive at the BP gas station, located at 1038 W Lakeshore Dr, Manistique

*******PLEASE NOTE*******

Because all times are approximate, please plan to arrive at each pick up location at least 15 minutes early. The same applies for parents who are picking up the students on the return trip. That way, if we are running early, we will have the option to continue without waiting. Also, we will leave each location **exactly** on time. ***If you are not at your scheduled pick-up location by the scheduled leave time, we will continue to the next location.*** If you arrive too late to be picked up at your scheduled location, you can travel on to the next pick-up location. Anyone who misses their scheduled pick-up is responsible for their own transportation to Boys/Girls State

ADDITIONAL STOPS AVAILABLE ALONG LOWER MICHIGAN ROUTE WITH ADVANCE NOTICE

If you would like to be picked up or dropped off in Lower Michigan along the route, you must make prior arrangements with the driver, John M. Mella. The cost to ride the bus will be determined at that time.

The route downstate from the Upper Peninsula is I-75 south, to 127 south, to MSU.
The return route is from MSU, to 127 north, to I-75 north to US-2 in the Upper Peninsula.
